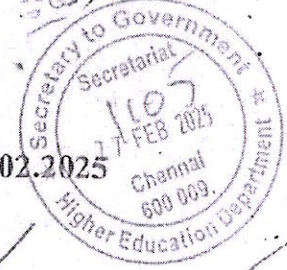

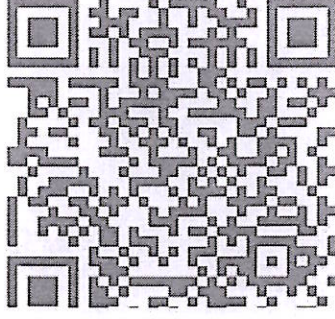
With Cybercrimes on the rise leading to significant financial losses due to lack of awareness amongst the public about the different modus operandi of cybercrimes and also due to delay in reporting the crimes, it is essential that college students and faculties are also aware of same, help us raise awareness on cybercrimes and also safeguard themselves against such frauds.

In this regard, following steps as initiated by Cyber Crime Wing of Tamil Nadu Police, may be helpful as detailed below:

1. Cybercrime Awareness Billboards on 1930 Helpline

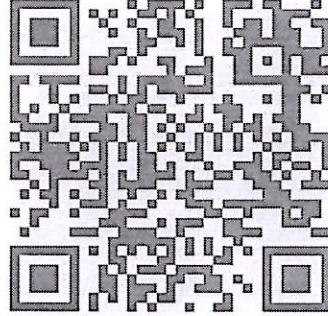
The 1930 Cyber Crime Helpline was recently expanded from 8 lines to 15 lines per shift with a total of 38 call takers on shift basis. Immediate reporting of cybercrimes through 1930 helps registration of cases and freezing the lost money, in tie up with banks and payment channels.

With a view to popularise and create awareness on 1930 Helpline, "Chennai 1930 Walkathon" was organized by Cyber Crime wing on 29.01.2025 and Cyber Crime Awareness Billboards and stickers on 1930 were designed, as in the QR code given below:



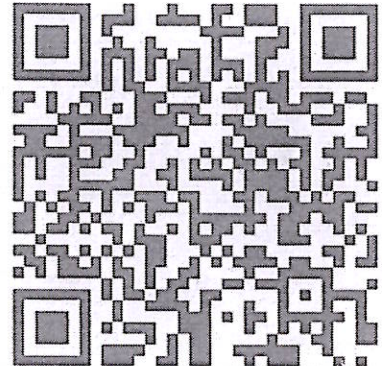
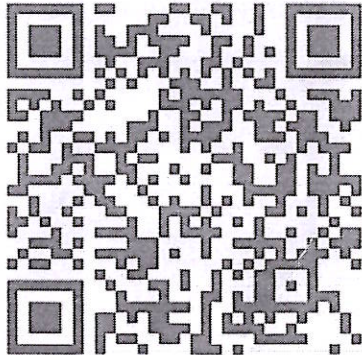
2. Cartoon Booklet Series on 30 selected trending Cybercrimes:

Efforts have been made to detail various Modus Operandi of cybercrimes in vogue. As these keep morphing, same shall be reflecting periodically by suitable modifications in the cartoon booklet series “சைபர் குற்றங்களும் தம்பியின் வழிகாட்டலும்” which can be downloaded by scanning the QR code.



3. Short films on Cyber Crime Awareness:

Two short films on awareness with respect to cybercrimes are also adduced herewith which can be disseminated for better reach.



4. The QR codes as given herein can be used to download and spread awareness messages on cybercrimes through printing and display at prominent places as far as Sl.No.1 is concerned, while Sl.No.2 and 3 can be shared widely in e-format itself for public reach.

5. It is requested that suitable instructions may be issued to Universities / Colleges to utilize these resources for better awareness and join our fight against cybercrimes.
